We are writing to update you on our works in Sept/Oct on the station

Upcoming Works Update

Following our previous communication regarding the works at Twickenham Station, we are writing to update you that the station will be closed on the weekends of the 29th/30th September 13th /14th October. We will be using this period to carryout the following activities.

- **29th/30th September**

Platform works, entailing installation of floors, paving slabs, drainage and foundations. Cladding to the lifts, stairs and maintenance deck. Scaffolding Alterations and removal of mega shore props

- **13th/14th October**

Removal of the Temporary footbridge and installation of a cabling for station services. Installation of remainder of station stairs and cladding finishes. Platform works, entailing installation of foundations for new canopy roof.

To complete the work, it is necessary for us to carry out activities during a possession, when the station is closed and there are no trains running. During this time, we will be able to use the possession to safely access between platform 3 and 4/5 and lift in the elements described above.

The times for the possession are below:

- 01:20am Saturday 29th September 2018 to 4:20am Monday 1st October 2018
- 01:20am Saturday 13th October 2018 to 4:20am Monday 15th October 2018

Preparation work will start at 22:00pm on the night prior to the possession and will finish at 06:00am on the Monday morning following site clearance and de-mobilisation.

This work will cause some noise disturbance. However we intend to reduce disruption by using site guard fencing with a layer of echo barriers and where possible certain disruptive activities will be undertaken during the daytime portions of the weekend. Noise monitoring will be in place to manage the works. We would like to thank you in advance for your patience, and apologies for any inconvenience caused.
