

# Notice of Upcoming Work at Twickenham Station

19<sup>th</sup> October 2018


Following our previous communication regarding the works at Twickenham Station, we are writing to update you that we will be carrying out the following overnight work activities;

- Excavating and Concreting the remaining foundations for the Platform canopies
- Installing remaining cladding to the podium stairs and lift shaft
- Alterations to the N/E elevation scaffold

These overnight works will take place over the following periods and at the locations shown in yellow below.

Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> November and take place every evening until Friday 9<sup>th</sup> November.

Friday 16<sup>th</sup> November and take place every evening until Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> November.





## Notice of Upcoming Work at Twickenham Station

19<sup>th</sup> October 2018

During this time, we will work without disrupting train and station operations and will use a line block to safely access the space in between platforms and lift in plant and materials over the railway lines. Preparation work will start from 10pm every evening and once the last train has departed the line block will commence at 1am and enable us to work until 5am, before clearing the site and completing work by 6am.

This work will involve the use of plant and equipment likely to create some noise disturbance. Fencing with a layer of echo barriers will be used to reduce the disturbance, and noise monitoring will be in place to manage the works. In addition we have also introduced a break in between each period noted to reduce the disturbance.
