Mary's Terrace – road widening update

We have been working to widen Mary's Terrace over the last few weeks.

We are writing to update you that our work will take slightly longer than we initially anticipated.

In order to complete the works as quickly and safely as we can, we will be working on Saturday 12th August (trackside only) and Saturday 19th August. On 19th August, the junction will be closed between 8am and 3pm. Traffic marshals will control access to Mary's Terrace from Beauchamp Road.

We now anticipate completing these widening works on Friday 25th August.

Following the completion of the widening work, we will open Station Yard car park, where 15 spaces are provided for cars affected by this closure. To claim a permit to park here please email your vehicle registration number, address and contact details to community@twickenhamforward.com or call 0207 729 1705. This car park is expected to be available from Saturday 26th August.

We will then close part of Mary's Terrace – between Travelodge and the garages – to vehicles to enable the main station works to start. This is planned for Monday 28th August.


