

# Notice of Upcoming Work at Twickenham Station

We are writing to update you on our work in December 2017 and January 2018



8<sup>th</sup> December 2017

## Forthcoming work update

As we prepare for the arrival of two tower cranes in December and January, we will be carrying out additional work at night, during engineering hours (between 22:00 and 05:00) and on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> December (daytime).

Our next phase of work includes the movement of plant and materials to and from the Island Platform, located between platforms 3 and 4/5, as well as preparatory work to the Tower Crane foundations to ensure the smooth arrival of the first tower crane. We will also commence work to create a bridge over the railway. This will enable us to safely move materials onto the Island Platform even during railway operation hours and almost halve the need for overnight, engineering hours work for this activity.

From **Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> December until the morning of Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> December** (between 22:00 and 05:00) and **Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> December** (between 08:00-18:00) we will be undertaking this work. Railway services will not be affected by our work on Sunday 17 December.

This work may cause some noise disturbance. Site guard fencing with a layer of echo barriers will be used where practicable to reduce disruption, and real time noise monitoring will be undertaken to manage the works.

## Tower crane arrivals and forthcoming rail closures

We will use the planned service closure on **Christmas Day and Boxing Day** to receive and set up the first of two tower cranes. No disruption to London Road is anticipated and the construction activities will not have a significant noise impact. There are wider engineering works taking place during this time. Further weekend working will take place on **Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> January** as well as on **Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> January 2018**. The station will be closed on these days as part of wider engineering work, as well as work at the station. The next planned weekend closure will not be until Easter 2018. Potential future dates for work taking place during engineering hours (22:00 until 05:00) are listed overleaf.
