

Notice of Upcoming Work at Twickenham Station

We are writing to update you on our works in August on the station platforms



17th July 2017

Advance Preparation Works

In preparation for the upcoming demolition works in September, it is necessary for us to carry out advance activities at night using a combination of late evenings when passenger flows are reduced and engineering hours (01:20-04:20) when we will be working using line block access.

Commencing 29th July for 2 weeks (22:00 - 05:00), the following works will be undertaken:

- Completion of the remaining Temporary Footbridge Cladding and removal of platform canopy frame.
- Installation of Gallows Bracket Posts
- Delivery and removal of materials to the Island site between platform 4/5
- Installation of Customer information screens and equipment to platform 3, 4 and 5
- Installation of cabins using a mobile crane in the station carpark
- Installation of troughing units

This work will cause some noise disturbance. Site guard fencing with a layer of echo barriers will be used to reduce disruption, and noise monitoring will be undertaken to manage the works.

Widening Works

Due to the discovery of unknown services within the railway boundary, these works have been pushed back a week and will commence on the 24/07/17 for 4 weeks.
