## Notice of work at Twickenham Station

We are writing to update you on our work in May at Twickenham Station.

Over the next few weeks our presence on site will become more prominent. Initial site accommodation, including temporary cabins, will be installed in the car park. This will reduce the number of parking bays available.

Work on a temporary ticket office will also start shortly, this will be sited on the current event day gate. Initial work will include clearing this area.

We will also continue our trackside work – relocating cables and location box installations.

There will be no other impacts on access to the station at this time.

## Junction of Mary's Terrace and Beauchamp Road

We will also be erecting some fencing in and around Mary's Terrace. This will be in readiness for the widening works scheduled to take place in July.

The widening works of Mary's Terrace are limited to the bend at the top of the terrace, on the junction with Beauchamp Road. This is in order to provide better access for emergency services and refuse lorries.
