We are writing to update you on our works in February on the station

Upcoming Works Update

Engineering hours work

Following our previous communication regarding the works at Twickenham Station, we are writing to update you that we will be moving material and plant from Platform 3 to the Island Platform. To complete these works, it is necessary for us to carry out activities at night, using engineering hours when the station is closed. During this time, we will be able to use a line block to safely access between platform 3 and 4/5, without disrupting train and station services.

Unless noted, preparation work will commence at 10pm (on the evenings noted below). Once the last train has departed the station, the line block will commence around 1am (on the mornings noted below) and enable us to work until 5am, before clearing the site and completing the works by 6am.

The works will commence on:

- 16th February 2018 (working Friday evening into Saturday morning)
- 17th February 2018 (working Saturday evening into Sunday morning)
- 20th February 2018 (working Tuesday evening into Wednesday morning)
- 21th February 2018 (working Wednesday evening into Thursday morning)
- 22th February 2018 (working Thursday evening into Friday morning)

This work will cause some noise disturbance. Site guard fencing with a layer of echo barriers will be used to reduce disruption, and noise monitoring will be in place to manage the works.

Sunday 18th February 2018

Following discussions with Richmond Council, we have agreed to conduct some work on the car park near the temporary station on Sunday 18th February rather than overnight. This is to prevent significant noise disturbance overnight. This includes updating line markings in the car park and along the station approach road. To enable this, the station car park will be closed on Sunday 18th February. The station and train services will not otherwise be affected by this work.
