

# Notice of Upcoming Work at Twickenham Station

## Upcoming Works Update

### 52-hour Possession Works

Following our previous communication regarding the works at Twickenham Station, we are writing to update you that we will be carrying out the following activities during a 52-hour weekend possession:

- Lifting in and installing Precast Concrete beams using the Tower Cranes. These are the main podium beams on which the main building will be built up from.

To complete these works, it is necessary for us to carry out these activities during a 52-hour possession, when the station is closed and there are no trains running. During this time, we will be able to use the possession to safely access between platform 3 and 4/5 and lift in the precast concrete beams.

During this period the station will have a bus replacement service in operation and we will have a lane closure on London Road bridge with a pedestrian diversion route in place.

The times for the possession are as noted below;

01:20am Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2018 to 04:20am Monday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2018 (Preparation work will commence at 22:00pm (on the night of Friday 27<sup>th</sup> April) and will cease at 06:00am on the Monday morning following site clearance and de-mobilisation.

This work will cause some noise disturbance. Site guard fencing with a layer of echo barriers will be used to reduce disruption, and noise monitoring will be in place to manage the works. Thank you in advance for your patience, and apologies for any inconvenience caused.
