

# Notice of Upcoming Work at Twickenham Station

We are writing to update you on our works in August



16<sup>th</sup> August 2017

## New station entrance

On Friday 25<sup>th</sup> August 2017, the entrance to Twickenham Station will move to a temporary station located in the car park, adjacent to Platform 3 – see plan overleaf. Ahead of this important milestone for the project, we will be undertaking additional work on-site, including during the weekend and overnight.

We will be working on-site on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> August and Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> August, as well as on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> August 2017. Our Saturday working hours will be extended from 8am until 8pm and our Sunday working hours will be 10am until 6pm. This work will include fitting out the new ticket office, completing the new car parking arrangements. We will also be completing the widening works in Mary's Terrace.

From the 29<sup>th</sup> August 2017, we will commence overnight works, during line blocks, ahead of the first possession in September.

## Forthcoming possessions and preparation work

Following the opening of the new station entrance, our work focuses on the September possessions. We will be working overnight ahead of this, from Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> August 2017 for two weeks. Our work will include removing the internal fixings and cladding from the existing footbridge. This might cause some noise disturbance, which we will do all we can to minimize, including using acoustic barriers where possible.

We have two Sunday possessions, lasting 28 hours (01:00 Sunday until 04.20 Monday) on the 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> September, when there are also be wider engineering work taking place in the area and the demolition of the station footbridge. 
